OKC metro area: The 1,190 teen births in Oklahoma County and the seven other counties in the metro area totaled one-third (34%) of the 3,534 teen births in the state in 2019: Oklahoma (767), Canadian (76), Cleveland (150), Grady (51), Lincoln (26), Logan (23), McClain (24), and Pottawatomie (73).
