OKC metro area: There were **3,253** births in Oklahoma in 2020 to females aged 19 and younger. Of those, **one-third** (34%, 1,091 births) were in the eight counties that comprise the OKC metro area: Oklahoma (716), Canadian (67), Cleveland (132), Grady (37), Lincoln (25), Logan (23), McClain (30), and Pottawatomie (61).
