<u>OKC metro area</u>: There were **2,880** births in Oklahoma in 2023 to females aged 19 and younger. Of those, *one-third* (32%, 927 births) were in the eight counties that comprise the OKC metro area: Oklahoma (608), Canadian (64), Cleveland (110), Grady (31), Lincoln (28), Logan (24), McClain (15), and Pottawatomie (47).
